CETA CANYON CONFERENCE

Held at the Ceta Canyon Methodist Camp, near Happy, Texas
(approx. 30 miles south of Amarillo, TX)

REGISTRATION INFORMATION: Registrations are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If you would like to request a specific room, want to choose who you room with, or need a lower bunk, **Register EARLY – before March 15th (please!!!)**

- **Registration Fee Includes** - 2 nights lodging, 5 meals, late night snacks, **unlimited coffee** and admission to all conference events. You must be registered to attend any of this conference. No beds will be guaranteed without prepaid registration. Please do not just show up and hope for a bed without making prior arrangements.
- **Registration Fee** - is **\$160.00** per person. **Registration fees are - Non-Refundable.** If at the last minute you find that you can't come, you may transfer it to another person (preferably same sex). If you arrange for someone else to use your registration, please notify Registrar prior to conference if possible. If you are unable to use your registration for medical/family emergency reasons, your registration can be rolled-over to the next year, but only by conference board approval. Please do not try to come for only a part of the conference and ask for a reduced rate - even if you live in the area - it is against our conference "rules". Come for all or none. Thank you!
- **Registration Begins - 1:00 p.m. Friday - at Garrison Lodge at the top of the hill, watch for signs.**
- **Registration confirmations** - If you provide an E-mail address, we will notify you by E-mail.

GARRISON LODGE is dormitory style (men and women separate), **with** very nice, motel-style rooms. Each room has a private shower room and bathroom with large mirrors between them. Garrison Lodge is also well handicapped equipped. All rooms have heat and air.

WHAT TO BRING? Please bring your pillow, sleeping bag (or sheets and blankets, if you prefer), towels, wash cloths, soap, shampoo, flashlight (to go to campfire meetings), hiking or tennis shoes (if you plan to walk to the falls), etc. Weather is unpredictable in the canyon - so pack accordingly.

PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED? Please don't let that stop you from coming. Rooms in Garrison are very handicapped friendly with support bars in both the shower room and bathroom. There are no steps from rooms in Garrison to conference room. There are steps to the dining hall and other buildings. Transportation will be available for those requiring assistance to and from the dining hall and snack area.

"NIGHT OWLS" - We have a room to congregate all hours of the day or night. It's a great place for newcomers to hear (one-on-one or group) sage old-timer wisdom about the Big Book, working the steps and staying sober.

Camp Rules:

- **No alcohol or drugs.**
- Dress is casual - but please - no halter tops or short-short shorts, etc. It is a church camp, remember?
- **No SMOKING** - in any of the buildings! (Please use the cans & receptacles provided around the camp.)
- **No radios - No TV's - No CD Players - No Tape Players - No skateboards - No children - No pets.**

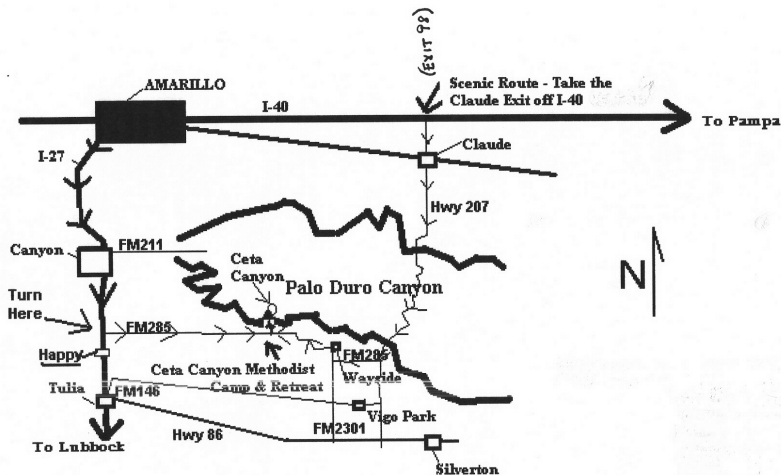

Scenic Route: This is an awesome experience!

From I-40 (approximately 66 miles west of Shamrock, Texas) Take the

Claude Exit (EXIT No. 98 - Highway 207) south to Claude, Texas. Stay on Highway 207, **REPEAT stay on Highway 207** going south out of Claude. You'll go about 20-25 miles. It's **FLAT-FLAT-FLAT ---- Then - all of a sudden - you'll be IN THE CANYON!** It is a beautiful, scenic (and spiritual) drive through a portion of the south part of the canyon. After coming out of the canyon, continue



on Highway 207 until you get to FM 285. Turn right on FM 285 - You won't be on it very long before it jogs a bit back north to go through Wayside (a very small town). When you get to Wayside, there's a church on the right. As soon as you pass the church, FM 285 turns to the left to go through Wayside (It's not marked well, but if you go straight - you end up in a field). Stay on FM 285 for about 10 miles. When you get to farm road signs such as "Goathead", "Jackrabbit" and "Parsley" - you are getting close. The camp signs are at FM 1721. Turn right (north) on FM 1721 and go about 2-1/2 miles into the camp.

(Note: It is approximately - a 45 minute drive from Claude this way - but very WORTH it!)

or --- Route from Amarillo: Take I-27 south out of Amarillo. South of the exits for Palo Duro Canyon and Canyon, Texas, watch for the Wayside exit (FM 285). Exit to the right at the Wayside Exit, then go back left (east) for about 8 miles until you see the camp signs and/or FM 1721. Turn left (north) on FM 1721. It's about 2-1/2 miles into the camp.

Directions - Entrance into Camp: As you reach the top of the camp, there's a horse statue up to the right and then a hairpin curve down into the canyon. Drive past the houses. You'll see the sign for Ceta Canyon Methodist Camp - keep to the right, cross the little creek ... and you're THERE!
