Kansas Area 25 Corrections Pre-Release & Correspondence



The Kansas Area 25 Corrections Committee encourages those Alcoholics that are interested in serving members of our fellowship that are currently incarcerated. Two of these areas of service are Pre-Release and Correspondence. In order to familiarize those potentially interested in this area of service, this brief summary outlines what each program entails.

Pre-Release: The AA Corrections Prerelease Contact Program connects the AA member being released from prison with Alcoholics Anonymous in their community. When the soon-to-be-released AA inmate writes us, we match that person to a Prerelease Contact in their community. If you are interested in this form of service, we will call you, get the okay, and then send you the name of a contact.

Correspondence: The Corrections Correspondence Service is a Twelfth Step opportunity which links members on the "outside" with A.A members in correctional facilities to provide a source of experience as it relates to problems with alcohol. Men are linked with men and women are linked with women.
